Our season isn't over, yet.....

Now that our machines are stored until next season, we still have work to do as snowmobilers. First, Jim Meinert's land as well as his house and buildings are up for sale, and since our trail crosses his land, we will stay in contact with him to follow the purchase and to stay in touch with the new owner (when sold) to see if we can keep our trail system intact. Second, the rails to trails program is back in action regarding the railroad bed from the north side of West Bend and all the way up to Eden. If the DNR does approve of this purchase, it will increase the total miles of multi-use trails in Wisconsin. Please contact your legislator(s) and let him or her know your views and feelings by phone, mail, or email to inform them that this is a very good purchase and will be an asset to Wisconsin.
